5. Will you share the contact information of Democrats on state party lists with the central committees of county parties?
6. What shape or form should revenue sharing between the state party and county central committees take?
7. What does health care reform need to achieve in order for you to consider the current effort a success?
8. Describe your sense of urgency is addressing climate change issues. How do you communicate with people who do not share whatever sense of urgency you described about climate change issues?
9. Labor unions and conservationists are traditional Democratic constituencies whose interests sometimes diverge. How will you keep Montana Democrats' agenda broad enough to encompass both?
